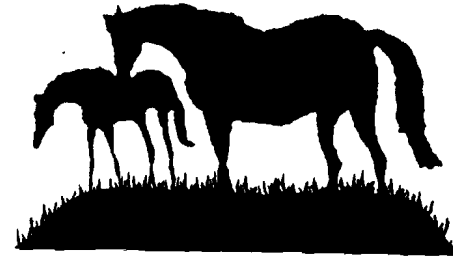

Federation Entry Agreement

By entering a Federation -licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employe and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of U.S.E.F.Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcast, internet film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. The likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation Rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed New York State. See GR908.4.

Federation Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification: This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition Salt River Farm to the following:

I AGREE that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used herein includes the Licensee and Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaultor, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm").

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition. I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and if applicable, EV114, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition. I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form.

All measurements cards, amateur cards, necessary association number and signatures must appear on all entry blanks before any numbers will be given out.

Permissible test for the Short Stirrup Equitation is USEF Hunter Seat Equitation Test #1 (Halt and/or back).

Courses for all short stirrup classes must consist of cross rails not to exceed 18". In the Short Stirrup Hunters Section, course must contain 1 change of direction.

10. **Stabling:** Permanent stabling available for those entries requesting by the closing date. No st doors or initial bedding provided. Stall fee Daily \$50.00 Overnight \$150.00.

11. **LIFE, SENIOR Active AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR MEMBER COMPETITIONS, Event competitions at the Preliminary level or above and combine training competitions at the advance level, dressage reining and vaulting competitions and endurance rides provided the respective breed discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at regular member competitions, event competitions, dressage competitions, reining competitions, and combined driving competitions upon payment of \$30 non member registration fee. Participants in THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE: 1) LEADLINE 2) exhibitions; 3) games races; 4) classes for 4-H members and 5) walk/trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux, quadrille classes; 7) NRHA endorsed Reining competitions Also exempt from this requirement are citizens of other nations who have proof in English of current membership in good standing of the own National Federation, 8.) USEA beginner novice division; and 9.) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.**

11a. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with R1 Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. (see GR901.29).

12. Stalls Close Two (2) Weeks Before Start Of Show.

13. **Refunds:** No refunds will be made on stalls after the closing date of entries.

Entry fees will be refunded only upon presentation of a certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian; all certificates to be considered must be received by show management before the end of show. An office Fee Of \$25.00 per legitimately excused animal will be deducted from the re

14. Course diagrams will be posted at least one hour prior to each class. Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle.

15. **Description Of Courses;** Courses in the Jumper Division will consist of brush, white pole, striped pole, oxers, panels with pole, white gate, stone, wall, triple bar, double in and out and triple in and out. Courses for all Jumper classes will be posted ¼ hour prior to classes. Hunte consist of Gates, brush, walls, panels, or any combination thereof.

16. **Ties:** Ties involving first place in the Jumper Division must be jumped off (Rule JP 141) Horses that are tied for other than first place shall remain tied and the prize money shall be equally divided among the tied horses. Each shall receive a ribbon. Equal points will be awarded.

17. **Jumping order for Jumpers (Rule JP 112).** The horses' names are drawn individually, starting with the first position and then working down. Orders will be announced and posted one hour before the class. A dotted line may be instituted to limit the size of opening circles if entries require.

18. **Salt River Farm Horse Show** is a member of the Long Island High Score Awards Association. All points won at this show will count toward the annual Long Island High Score Awards. Exhibitors' attention is drawn to the requirements in regard to the specified number of shows in which an exhibitor must compete in order to be eligible to receive an award in a particular division or section.

19. Management retains the right to cancel any division with fewer than the minimum required by the rules. If there are fewer than the minimum required by the rules. If there are fewer than 8 horses or 1 ties in any "A" rated section there will be a \$35 surcharge. In the jumper classic there must be eight entr or the prize money will be forfeited.
